# E. <u>EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION</u>

Mike Unger, Director – Madera Rescue Mission. Mike Unger discussed the program at the Madera Rescue Mission they see approximately 100 – 130 people each night. There is a 9 month and a 12 month program and transitional living available. There are also beds available for people who have mental illness. The beds available are 10 for men and 2 for women. The parameters are different for these participants, they can stay at the Rescue Mission all day. Medication can be stored at the Rescue Mission however not dispensed. The participants are encouraged to get connected to Behavioral Health Services.
