Mariam Agayan, LMFT, Supervising Mental Health Clinician — Pine Recovery Center: Full Service Partnerships, AB109, Hope House Liaison, P Street Housing — Pine Recovery Center has 6 Clinicians, and 6 caseworkers that serve children to older adults. Full Service Partnerships provide intensive mental health services for clients with more needs. AB109 funds have been used to reserve 10 beds at Madera Rescue Mission. At the Mission clients receive services and it provides structure. Behavioral Health Court has been successful. There will be a new judge and hope to continue to have a good working relationship.

H. DIRECTOR'S CORNER - Dennis P. Koch, MPA Director, Behavioral Health Services

Dennis P. Koch, Director, MPA – Behavioral Health Services budget will be ready for this Board by the May meeting. Not much will change. There was an increase in salaries – 3% increase this year and 3% next year. The Governor's budget has been released. Three main categories of bills being submitted: (1) Opioid Crisis. (2) Homelessness - BHS has submitted the No Place Like Home application to State which will fund a 40-60 unit complex behind Carl's Jr., next to the freeway. (3) MHSA – Currently have \$6 million in prudent reserve to use if the economy goes down. New bill only allows to keep certain amount, for us \$3 million. Thinking of ideas to spend the money – Solar panels for 7th Street, a structured living facility. Another new bill would give County responsibility to treat mild to moderate mental illness or refer client to their Health Plan.
