This is a three year grant that expires on June 30, 2020, which funds a School Resource Deputy for Golden Valley Unified School District.

ESTIMATED REVENUES

- **721900** Special Departmental Expense (\$56,601) is recommended to pay for swag, signage, and special equipment.
- **Transportation and Travel Expense** (\$5,000) is recommended to pay for travel and education expenses for the School Resource Deputy.
