

NOTES:

- 1. ROAD SURFACE MUST BE CAPABLE OF SUPPORTING A 40,000 POUND TOTAL VEHICLE WEIGHT UNDER ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS. MAY INCLUDE A GRAVEL SURFACE AS DETERMINED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER AND AS APPROVED BY THE COUNTY.
- 2. COPIES OF R-VALUE AND COMPACTION TESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE ROAD DEPARTMENT FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.
- 3. FOR ONE WAY ROADS AND DRIVEWAYS WHICH ARE A MINIMUM OF 10 FEET WIDE, TURNOUTS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED PER ST-27. TWO WAY ROADS AND DRIVEWAYS WHICH ARE 20 FEET WIDE ARE NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE TURNOUTS.
- 4. AGRICULTURAL PROPERTIES WHICH ARE DESIGNATED A—(AGRICULTURAL) AND AE—(AGRICULTURAL EXCLUSIVE) IN THE GENERAL PLAN, AHWAHNEE/NIPINNAWASEE PLAN, OAKHURST PLAN, AND RESOURCE CONSERVATION (PUBLIC OPEN SPACE) IN THE O'NEALS AND NORTH FORK PLANS ARE EXEMPT FROM THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE COUNTY STANDARD DRAWINGS ST—8, NUMBERS 1, 4 AND 5; AND ST—27, NUMBER 1.
- 5. FUTURE UPGRADING TO A DIFFERENT ROAD CLASS MAY REQUIRE A WIDER TRAVELED WAY.
