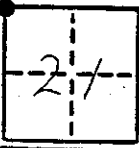

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH
Found and Accepted: A 2" O.D.I.P., up 11", with a 2" dia. brass cap, stamped for the corner (see cap inscription), in a 3' dia. x 1/2' high rock mound. Found 4 original bearing trees per GLO field notes of J. M. Anderson U.S. Deputy Surveyor 1881.

 Left monument as found. Posted Forest Service monument signs on a 5" dia. Red Fir 4' ± SW of the corner.

4. Fir remains, bear N 47° 59' W, 25.1'.

New Bearing Objects:

5. A Red Fir, 12.8" dia., bears N 20° 49' E, 47.09'.
6. A Tamarack, 11.7" dia., bears S 71° 04' E, 69.46'.
7. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in a rock, 4' x 4' x 2' high, bears S 15° 49' E, 41.71'.

8. A chiseled "+" in a rock 3' x 4' x 1 1/2' high, bears S 66° 15' 48" W, 33.88'.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown.
