PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

**FOUND AND ACCEPTED:** A 2 1/2" O.D.I.P., up 9" in a rock mound 1' dia. x 3" high, with a brass cap in top of pipe stamped for the corner (see cap inscription). Found 2 original bearing trees per field notes of J.M. Anderson, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1881.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

Left monument as found. Rebuilt rock mound 2 1/2' dia. x 1/2' high around monument. Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached 4' ± SW of the corner.

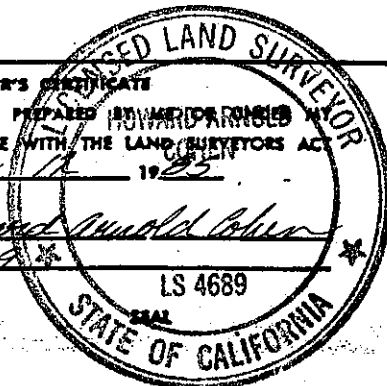
