**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH**

Found and Accepted: An 18" dia., 4" high rock mound. Found 2 original bearing trees per GLO field notes of J. M. Anderson, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1881. This is an original corner position per U.S. Forest Service corner records dating back to 1940.

**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED**

Remonumented found rock mound with a F.S.M., up 9". Rebuilt rock mound 2 1/2' x 2' x 9' high. Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached 4' ± NW of the corner.

F.S.M. - Aluminum monument, 2 1/2" O.D., 30" long with a 3 1/4" O.D. aluminum cap stamped for the corner, with LS 4689, the date and the Forest Service logo.

6. A White Fir, 6" dia., bears N 80° 23' W, 20.43'.

Found a 2 1/2" O.D.I.P., tagged LS 3920, up 8", in a 2' dia. x 6" high rock mound,  
S 84° 35' 43" E, 45.66'--- NOT ACCEPTED.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

Posted Forest Service monument and bearing tree signs.

Stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1973 " Manual of Surveying Instructions".

Monument is in open area 75' West of crest of ridge.

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
