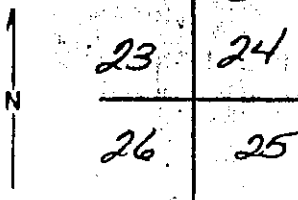

At SW Coeuer of intersection of Fences to N, S, E & W  
Found 1 1/4" Diameter Iron pipe with nail and tag  
RCE 21650 in a rock mound. Accepted as perpetuation  
of original corner.

DESCRIBE BEARING TREES OR OTHER OFFICIAL ACCESSORIES FOUND

- 1) Found Remains of Oak Stump bearing N 72°06' E, 106.54'  
(Black Oak, 20" Diameter Bears N 71°E, 108.24' GAD)
- 2) Found depression with Oak remains bearing 573°15' E  
71.80' (Black Oak 26" Diameter, Bears 570°E, 75.9' GAD)
- 3) No evidence of other original bearing trees.
