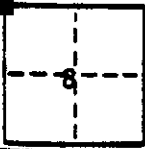

Found and Accepted: A 2 1/2" O.D., I.P. with a 2" dia., brass cap stamped for the corner up 12" in a rock mound 3' at the base and 1' high. Found 2 original bearing trees per GLO notes of Mark Howell, Deputy Surveyor, 1874. Reference: Corner record by W.O. Gentry, 1976, M.C.O.R.

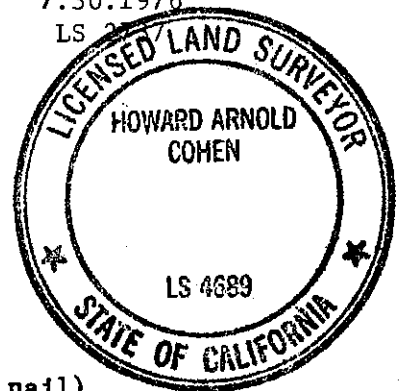
6. A Sequoia Stump, 108" dia., bears S 16° 51'E 63.7'. (no nail)

STATEMENT ON BACK OF SHEET



8. A White Fir, 8.5" dia., bears S 72° 56'W; 37.49'.

- Set a 1 1/4" O.D., I.P. 32" long, up 4" on property line, S 20° 07' 46"W; 118.4'.

Set a P.K. nail and tag in top stamped: $\begin{array}{c} P \quad L \\ | \\ \cdot \\ LS \quad | \quad 4689 \end{array}$

- Set a 1 1/4" O.D., I.P., 32" long, up 2" on property line, S 88° 42' 40"W; 69.6'.

Set a P.K. nail and tag in top stamped: $\begin{array}{c} P \quad L \\ | \\ \cdot \\ LS \quad 4689 \end{array}$

- Found a 4" x 2" x 2 1/2' high wooden post with scribing on 4 sides, 1' SW of corner.

• Bearing are to the center of trees at base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

• Posted Forest Service Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

• Blazed and scribed trees #4, 7, and 8, in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instructions."
