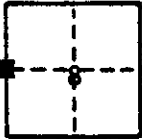

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found and Accepted: A 2 1/2" O.D., I.P. with a 2" dia., brass cap stamped for the corner, up 10" above rock mound 4' at the base and 1' high. Found 2 original bearing trees per GLO notes of Mark Howell, Deputy Surveyor, 1874. Reference: Corner record by W.O. Gentry 1976, M.C.O.R.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED

Left monument as found. Set a metal post with a Forest Service K-Tag and monument sign in a drill hole 3.7' SE of corner.

Original Bearing Trees

1. An Incense Cedar Stump 5' high, 25" dia., with visible scribing, bears N 39° 06'E; 29.25'.
2. A Black Oak Stump 2' high, 29" dia., with healed blaze, bears S 81° 16'W; 30.1' (no nail)

New Bearing Objects

3. A Black Oak, 13.7" dia., bears N 45° 09'E; 50.46'.
4. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in rock on E. Side of Nelder Creek bears S 63° 18' 12"E; 35.19'.
5. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in rock outcrop, bears S 20° 23' 48"W; 19.98'.

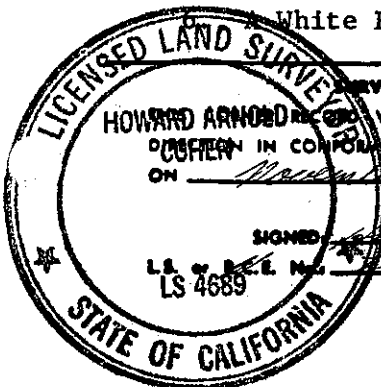
