

Geographical Assessment and Assets & Risk Factors Mapping Based on Health Inequities

INTRODUCTION

The results from secondary and primary data sources, conducted as part of the Community Health Assessment (CHA), both identified diabetes as a major health concern in Madera County. This was the main reason why diabetes, along with obesity, was chosen by the Live Well Madera County Coalition (LWMC-C) to be one of the four priorities to be addressed in the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).



METHODS


An additional analysis of the primary data, consisting of 2,081 electronic and in-person surveys with reported zip code, was conducted to assess for disparities based on geographical locations. Stratification of the question "What are the three biggest health problems in your community?" by zip codes provided information to identify disparity by geographical locations. Stata, Microsoft Excel, and ArcMap were utilized for the analysis and identification of community asset(s). Primary and secondary Geographic Information Mapping (GIS) sources were utilized to identify risk factors and assets around diabetes in Madera County, specifically 93638. Asset factors include parks, farmers markets, WIC clinics, and general grocery stores. Risk factors include fast food, pizza, sandwiches locations, and poverty density (less than 125% FPL).

GIS mapping of parks was completed by the Madera County Department of Public Health. Secondary GIS data around risk factors and additional assets and were obtained from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH)'s Nutrition Education and Obesity Prevention Branch GIS Map Viewer database.


RESULTS OF PRIMARY DATA ANALYSIS AND JUSTIFICATIONS FOR TARGET IDENTIFICATION OF RISK FACTORS AND ASSETS IN 93638

The analysis presented in chart 1 illustrated that there was geographical variation in zip codes around the concern of diabetes in the community. A higher proportion (36%) of responders from 93638 reported diabetes to be one of the three biggest health problems in their community compared to other zip codes such as 93610 (23%), 93636 (29%), and 93637 (30%). Since responders from 93638 comprised of 47.14% of responders, besides proportions, numbers of responder from each major zip codes and their report of biggest health problems were also analyzed in chart 2. This additional observation provided evidence on burden of diabetes. The large disparity was even more apparent as 349 of the responders reported diabetes as one of the three biggest health problems in their community compared to 199 responders for 93637, 15 responders in 93636, and 57 responders in 93610. This indicated that diabetes was ranked the #1 health concern in 93638 by both depictions of count and proportion of responders. The Madera County Department of Public Health is interested in not only the risk factors that might contribute to this disparity, but also the potential assets that can be exploited to mediate diabetes.

Parks:

Assets in 93638 include community parks. There are a total of six parks located in the target zip code. As demonstrated in figure 1, parks are not equally distributed across the 93638 geographical areas. All parks are concentrated around southern 93638.






Figure 2: WIC Clinic in Target Zip Code - 93638

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
Figure 3: Farmers Market(s) in Target Zip Code - 93638

There is one farmer market located in 93638. The farmers market is located in the southern part of 93638. This farmers market does accept EBT.



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Grocery Stores:






Figure 6: Poverty in Target Zip Code - 93638

Madera County Risk Factors- Poverty

Poverty (Density of individuals less than 125% under the FPL:

There is a high density of individuals living below the 125% Federal Poverty Line in the southern part of 93638. Specific areas with the greatest impact includes 06039000602 and 06039000800 census tract locations.



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CONCLUSION

Despite having both assets and risk factors, the locations that appeared most impacted are in the southern census tracts of 93638. Poverty is great in this area. Southern 93638 is also the population center, having a high population density compared to the rest of the zip code. Despite having many grocery stores, these stores are often small with some stores clearly being gas stations or convenience stores rather than true grocery stores where fresh fruits and vegetables can be purchased. There is also a large number of fast food chains in this area. In order to mediate diabetes in 93638, additional analysis such as the availability of fresh fruits and vegetables should be conducted. Interventions can include increasing access to fruits and vegetables by expanding farmers market services. Other information that will be useful to compare with reported perceived health problem in the community is diabetes prevalence in 93638. Analysis of the perceived health concern in 93638 with the true burden of disease can confirm or deny diabetes as being one of the biggest health problems in this community.
