**TITLE:** Madera County Declares Local Health Emergency

At this time, the risk of illness has not changed. However, school closures have a cascading effect on other government services. This declaration provides flexibility to County leadership in managing our workforce and other resources as we respond to COVID-19 and maintain other essential government services. The declaration of emergency helps the County access resources, reassign staff to new roles, and implement plans that make it easier to serve the community.
