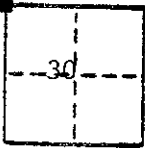

CORNER - LEFT AS FOUND FOUND AND TAGGED REESTABLISHED OBLITERATED CORNER REBUILT

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found and Accepted; A 1" O.D., I.P.; 30" long, up 3" above rock mound, 2 1/2' at the base and 1/2' high, Pipe is untagged, Found possible remains of 1 original bearing tree per survey of Archibald McNeil in 1858. This monument is locally recognized and appears on many survey plats filed in Madera County Records, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner position.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED

Remonumented with F.S.M., up 9". Placed found pipe inside of F.S.M.

Built a rock mound 3' at the base and 1' high around monument. Set a metal post with a Forest Service K-tag and attention sign 4'+ N of the monument.

F.S.M. - Aluminum monument, 2-1/2" O.D., 30" long with a 3-1/4" O.D. aluminum cap; stamped for the corner, with LS 4689, the date and the Forest Service logo.

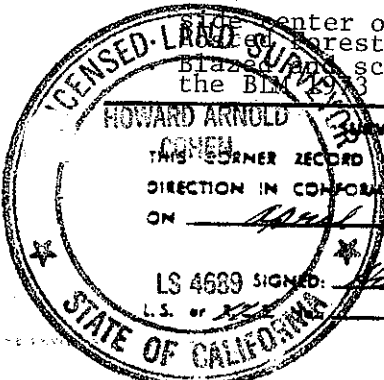
Corner Ties

- 1) A forked Black Oak (5 forks), 20.1" dia, bears N 55° 59' E.; 39.93'. Note: Diameter, bearing, and distance pertain to the SE Fork.
- 2) A Ponderosa Pine, 13.4" dia., bears S 3° 39' E; 44.02'.
- 3) A chiseled '+' in a large rock outcrop, bears S 77° 53' 59" W; 76.20'.
- 4) A Chiseled '+' in a large rock outcrop, bears N 33° 22' 01" W; 113.47'.
- 5) An old nail and shiner on top of a rock 6' x 4' x 6' high, bears N 70° 18' 13" W; 97.05'.
- 6) A depression, 5' dia., bears N 26° 57' W; 83'. (Record: Pine, 16" dia. N 23 1/2° W; 117 lks (77'))
 - . Corner lies N 88° 25' 14" E; 2657.24' from N 1/4 corner S. 25, 6/21.
 - . An intermittent creek flowing S. 25° W, lies 21' West of corner.
 - . An intermittent creek flowing S. 25° W, lies 37' North of corner.
 - . Bearings are to the center of trees at base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the center of the root crown.
 - . Forest Service Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
 - . Blazed and scribed trees and stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1933 "Manual of Surveying Instructions."
