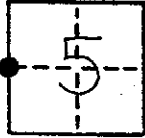

**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH**

**Found and Accepted:** A F.S.M. (LS 4727), up 12", in an 18" dia., 6" high rock mound, stamped for the corner (see cap inscription).

Found the remains of 2 original bearing trees per field notes of J. M. Anderson, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, 1881.

**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED**

Left monument as found.

Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached 4' ± NW of the corner.

F.S.M. - Aluminum monument, 2 1/2" O.D., 30" long with a 3 1/4" O.D. aluminum cap stamped for the corner, the date and the Forest Service logo.

1. A rotting pine, bears S 02° 43' W, 50.0'. (No Nail)
2. Oak remains, bear N 35° 39' W, 19.8'. (No Nail)

New Bearing Trees:

3. A Ponderosa Pine, 27.8" dia., bears N 58° 50' E, 10.61'.
4. A Ponderosa Pine, 10.1" dia., bears S 48° 32' E, 56.49'.
5. A Ponderosa Pine, 18" dia., bears S 87° 28' W, 40.84'.

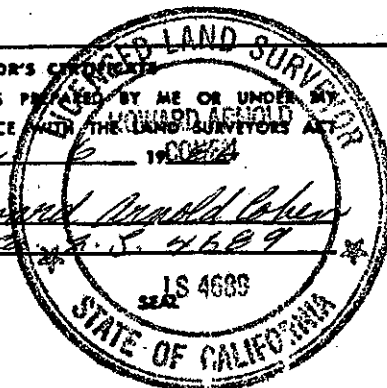
