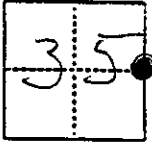

1. A 15.3" DIA. WHITE OAK SNAG WITH VISIBLE SCRIBING BEARS N.1 3/4°E. 94.38' (N.5°W. 94.38')
2. A 17.2" DIA. WHITE OAK BEARS N.88 1/2°E. 5.28' (N.86°E. 5.28')

NEW TIES:

3. A FORKED WHITE OAK _____ 10" AND 12" DIA. BEARS N.42°E. 46.65'
4. A 5 1/2" DIA. WHITE OAK BEARS S.15°W. 47.70'
5. A 7" DIA. WHITE OAK BEARS N.48°W. 91.07'

CORNER LIES 1 1/2' WEST OF A FENCELINE RUNNING N'LY AND S'LY
REMNANTS OF AN OLD FENCELINE RUN W'LY FROM CORNER
