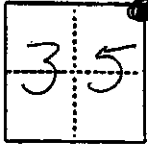

FOUND SCATTERED ROCK MOUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF RECORD DISTANCES FROM 3 ORIGINAL BEARING TREES.

REMONUMENTED ROCK MOUND WITH REBAR AND CAP, UP 6", REBUILT ROCK MOUND 2 1/2" DIA X 1/2" HIGH AROUND MONUMENT.

1. A 19.1" DIA. WHITE OAK WITH VISIBLE SCRIBING BEARS N.68 1/2°E. 50.3' (N.54°E. 46.9')
2. 20.6" DIA. WHITE OAK WITH VISIBLE SCRIBING BEARS S.40 1/4°E. 24.8' (S.72°E. 25.1')
3. A 2" DIA. DEAD AND DOWN DIGGER PINE BEARS S.32 1/4°W. 31.8' (S.21 W.28.4')
4. A 19.8" DIA. LIVE OAK WITH HEALED BLAZE BEARS N.41 1/2°W. 76.5'-(POSSIBLE ORIGINAL B.T. (N.45 1/2° W. 84.5') (BLACK OAK)

NEW TIES

5. A 6" DIA. WHITE OAK BEARS S.82°E. 33.35'
6. AN 8" DIA. WHITE OAK BEARS S.4°W. 39.38'

FOUND A 1 1/2" IRON PIPE WITH AN OVAL CAP STAMPED "R & I 1963" S.38 31'49"E. 22.52' FROM THE CORNER-NOT ACCEPTED THE FOUND PIPE LIES 1 1/2' W. OF INTERSECTION ON FENCES RUNNING N'LY, S'LY, E'LY AND W'LY
