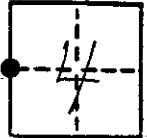

**Found and Accepted:** A 1" O.D. iron pipe, up 10", with a 2 1/2" dia. GLO brass cap stamped for the corner, the date and the GLO logo. Found 2 original bearing trees per field notes of A.W. Brown, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1917.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED  
 Left the monument as found.  
 Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached, 4' ± north of the monument.

Original Bearing Trees:

1. A Black Oak, 20" dia. bears N 74° E, 13.4'. (No Nail)
2. A Yellow Pine snag, 6" dia., 12' high, bears S 74° W, 12.1'. Scribing visible (No Nail)

New Bearing Trees:

3. A Sugar Pine, 4.5" dia., bears N 50° 11' W, 10.45'.
4. A Black Oak, 16.8" dia., bears N 29° 05' E, 45.57'.
5. A Black Oak, 17.3" dia., bears S 16° 21' E, 32.88'.

A fence, running easterly and westerly, lies 27' ± northerly of the corner monument.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

Posted Forest Service monument and bearing tree signs on the new bearing trees.

Blazed and scribed new bearing trees in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instructions".
