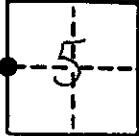

Found and Accepted: A 1" O.D. iron pipe, up 10", with a 2 1/2" dia. GLO brass cap stamped for the corner, the date and the GLO logo per field notes of A.W. Brown, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1917.

Left the monument as found.
Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached, 4' ± SE of the monument.

4. A Manzanita, 13" dia., bears S 50° 42' E, 45.47'.
