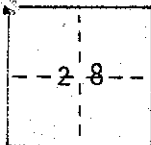

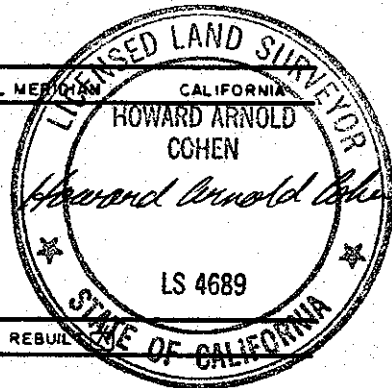

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

RECORD: An iron post, 3' long, 2" dia., 24" in ground, with a brass cap marked for the corner, per GLO notes of A. W. Brown, U.S.- Surveyor, 1917.

FOUND & : A 1-3/4" O.D., I.P., 36" long, up 25", with a brass cap marked: ACCEPTED in a rock mound 2 1/2' at the base and 1' high. Found 3 original bearing trees.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

SET: Standard FSM, up 12". Rebuilt rock mound 3' at the base and 1' high around monument. Buried GLO monument horizontally with FSM. Set a fiberglass post 4' ± NW of the monument with a Forest Service "Attention" sign attached.

FSM - Aluminum monument, 2 1/2" O.D., 30" long with a 3 1/4" O.D. aluminum cap; stamped for the corner, with L.S. 4689, the date, and a Forest Service logo.

- A black oak, 18.0" dia., bears S 80° 43' E, 26.52'. (Healed blaze)
- A live oak, 17.9" dia., bears S 78° 40' W, 25.49'. (scribing visible)
- A live oak, 9.6" dia., bears N 58° 40' W, 31.11'.

Other Bearing Objects

- A chiseled "+" in a boulder (6'x8'x8' high) in a group of large boulders in the center of an intermittent creek, bears N 85° 24' 00", 39.44'.
- A chiseled "+" in a boulder (7'x4'x3' high). bears S0° 08' 30" W, 13.45'.
- A chiseled "+" in a boulder (6'x4'x2' high) on top of small clump of same size boulders, bears S 56° 42' 00" W, 25.49'.
- A chiseled "+" in a boulder (4'x3'x4' high), bears N 17° 52' 36" W, 18.63'.
- . The corner lies in the bed of an intermittent creek (course N 83° E) in a rocky area.
- . Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail & tag (stamped L.S. 4689) driven into the side-center of the root crown.
- . Posted Forest Service monument and bearing tree signs.
- . Stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instruction."
