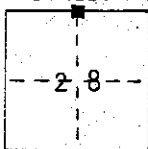
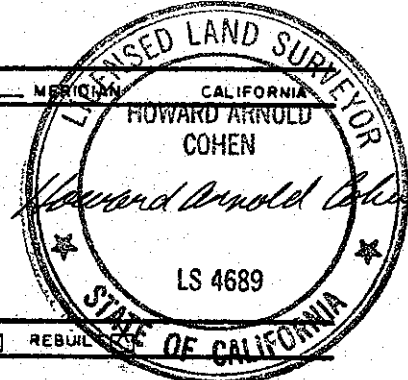

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

RECORD: A post, 4" dia., 2' in earth, 2' above, per GLO notes of W. F. Benson, U.S. Surveyor 1878,

FOUND & ACCEPTED: A 1" O.D., I.P., 22" long, ^{up 3"} tagged L.S. 2854, perpetuating the original corner position per parcel map No. 1159 filed with the Madera County Surveyor. Found 1 original bearing tree.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

SET: Standard FSM, up 6". Rebuilt a rock mound 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' at the base and $\frac{1}{2}$ ' high around the monument. Placed old monument upside-down in FSM. Set a fiberglass post 4' \pm SE of the monument with a Forest Service "Attention" sign attached.
 FSM - Aluminum monument, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " O.D., 30" long with a 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " O.D. aluminum cap; stamped for the corner, with L.S. 4689, the date, and a Forest Service logo.

Original Bearing Trees:

A ponderosa pine stump, 21.6" dia., bears N 49 $^{\circ}$ 40' E, 23.9'.

Other Bearing Objects:

- A live oak, 12.1" dia., (3 forks) bears N 16 $^{\circ}$ 50' E, 31.1' (previously established by L.S. 2854). NOTE: Diameter, bearing, and distance pertain to the south fork.
- A ponderosa pine, 9.1" dia., bears N 89 $^{\circ}$ 50' E, 71.47'. (Previously blazed chest high). NOTE: Distance is to a nail and tag up 3.4' in side-center of tree.
- A black oak, 12.3" dia., (2 forks), bears S 23 $^{\circ}$ 08' W, 82.27'.
NOTE: Diameter, bearing, and distance pertain to the north fork.
 Distance is to a nail and tag up 4' in side-center of tree.
- A draw (course N 40 W), bears S 23 $^{\circ}$ 08' W, 89'.
- An incense cedar, 23.2" dia., bears N 30 $^{\circ}$ 25' W, 30.8' (no Nail). (Previously est. R-11 by L.S. 2854.) 1-67
- A P.K. nail and tag, up 0.03', in a flat rock outcrop, bears S 67 $^{\circ}$ 27' 00" W, 56.51'. (Over)
- Fence lines bear S 84 $^{\circ}$ W and N 4 $^{\circ}$ E from corner.

STATEMENT ON BACK OF SHEET

- . Blazed and scribed new bearing trees and stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instructions."
- . Posted Forest Service monument and bearing tree signs.
- . Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped L.S. 4689) driven in the side-center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

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
