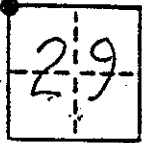

2. A Ponderosa Pine, 34.8" dia., bears N 58° 33' W, 16.03'. (healed blaze)
3. A Ponderosa Pine, 23.7" dia., bears N 30° 46' E, 29.26'. (healed blaze)
4. A Ponderosa Pine stump, 18" ± dia., bears S 33° 14' E, 19.4'. (no nail)

Fence lines run east, west and north from the corner.

A large pond lies 35' ± south and 45' ± west of the corner monument.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.
