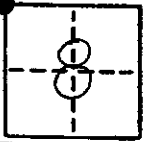

**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH**

Found and Accepted: A 2" O.D.I.P., up 8", with a 2" dia. brass cap, LS 4126, stamped for the corner (see cap inscription), in a 2' dia. x 8" high rock mound. Found 4 original bearing trees per GLO field notes of J. M. Anderson, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1881.

**PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED**

Left monument as found. Rebuilt rock mound 3' dia. x 8" high around monument. Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached, 4' ± SW of the corner.

4. A Yellow Pine, 27" dia., bears S 83° 10' W, 11.3'. (No Nail)

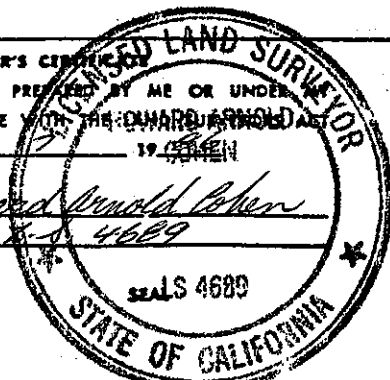

6. A Black Oak, 4.6" dia., bears S 16° 21' E, 17.99'.
7. A Ponderosa Pine, 23.7" dia., bears S 31° 12' W, 18.23'.
8. An Incense Cedar, 23.5" dia., bears N 50° 24' W, 49.31'.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.
