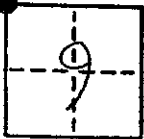

Found and Accepted: A 2" O.D.I.P., up 12", with a 2" dia. brass cap, LS 4126, stamped for the corner (see cap inscription). Found 3 original bearing trees per GLO field notes of J. M. Anderson, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1881.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

Built a rock mound 18" dia. x 6" high around monument.
Attached Forest Service monument signs to a 3" dia. Incense Cedar, S 71° E, 4.9' from monument.

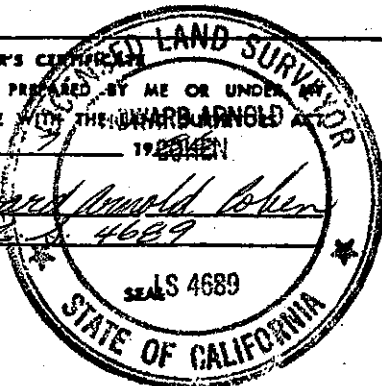

5. A Black Oak, 23.7" dia., bears S 88° 35' E, 84.74'.
6. An Incense Cedar, 27" dia., bears S 18° 38' W, 36.84'.
7. A Chiseled "+" in a rock, 4' x 6' x 2 1/2' high, bears N 88° 56' 18" W, 54.73'.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown unless otherwise noted.
