What Madera County Residents Should Know About Water Testing

Madera County is offering potable water testing for bacteria if you have a private domestic well and want to test your water. Private domestic wells are not regulated by the state and therefore no certification is required to test. The cost is \$15.00 per test. Please call (559) 675-7893 for details on where to pick up bottles and water sampling instructions. For residents that live in the mountain area we offer a testing drop off site at the Madera County Public Health Dept in Oakhurst every other week. Please call (559) 675-7893 for drop off times and details.

If you are a water system or resident testing for real estate purposes and need an ELAP/TNI Certified Laboratory to preform your potable water bacteria test, please see the list of Certified laboratories below that can help. There is also a web link included from the State Waterboards to help find other labs that are certified.
