DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

DISCUSSION:

On March 1, 2011 your Board approved the consolidation of the Madera County Mental Health and Alcohol Advisory Boards into a single Behavioral Health Board that convened on July 1, 2011. The authority for the Mental Health Board is provided by the State of California pursuant to Section 5604 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, so in combining the Boards we were mandated to continue to maintain a Board with a minimum of ten members citing mental health concerns as their primary reason for serving on the Board.

Legislation requires that Board members shall have a professional interest in or a personal commitment to mental health issues and/or alleviating problems related to alcohol/drug abuse in the community. Each of the recommended appointments is in accordance with this criteria.

The goal is to have equal representation from each district as stipulated within Article V of our Bylaws which states in part:

There shall be an equal number of appointees by each member of the Board of Supervisors. Each Supervisor shall appoint two members that cite mental health issues as their primary reason for serving on the Behavioral Health Board, and one member that cites AOD issues as their primary concern. The Board may recommend appointees to the Board of Supervisors.

Mr. Alammari resides in District No. 3, but since we already have two representatives from District 3 we are seeking his appointment to represent District No. 1, Ms. Prentice and Ms. Mullikin both reside in and represent District No. 5, and Ms. Simmons resides in District No. 5 however we are seeking her appointment as a representative for District No. 2.

On June 8, 2021 Nina J. Zarucchi-Mize was inadvertently appointed a new 3 year term by the Board of Supervisors to represent District No. 1, (resident of District 3) from 6/15/21 to 6/15/24. Ms. Zarucchi-Mize appointment was intended to fill the remaining term left by the resignation of Rick Farinelli whose term expires on March 1, 2023. The recommended action will correct the appointee's term and meet the requirements of the BHB bylaws.

The Behavioral Health Board unanimously approved the recommendation of Sadek Alammari and Jennifer Mullikin at their January 19, 2022 meeting, and Ginger Prentice and Maria Simmons at their March 23, 2022 meeting.

There are three (3) vacancies that remain to be filled for the districts listed below. Two representatives needed for Mental Health issues on behalf of Districts No. 1 and No. 4 and one for AOD/SUD issues on behalf of District No. 2.

Consideration of approval to submit the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Housing Loan Program ongoing Annual MHSA Fund Release form to request the release of unencumbered funds from the California Housing Finance Agency (MHSA) account for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and authorize the Department Head to sign.

DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the California Housing Finance Agency (CalHFA) jointly administer the MHSA Housing Program through an interagency agreement that expired on May 30, 2016. MHSUDS Information Notice No: 16-025 indicated If a county has financed a MHSA Housing Project the county must complete the Ongoing MHSA Fund Release Authorization for Future Unencumbered Funds (**Attachment A**). Attachment A is necessary because it advises CalHFA how to handle future funds that may be received by CalHFA on behalf of the county. These funds may include deposits of disencumbered MHSA Housing funds (i.e., COSR funds that are no longer required by a Project, or funds approved for a loan that is never funded), MHSA residual receipt loan payments, and accrued interest. Madera County currently has an estimated \$16,457 for Hinds House and \$8,066 for Chowchilla 4 plex. The County must use the funds to continue to support these MHSA housing projects. Funds can be used for housing assistance to include rental assistance, security deposits, utility deposits or

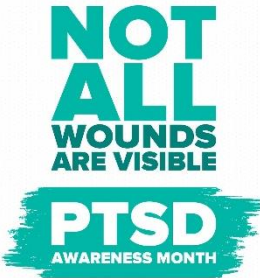
