Secured Property Tax Bills for FY 2022-23 Mailed First Installment due November 1, 2022

Madera County Treasurer-Tax Collector, Tracy Kennedy announced that over 59,000 secured property tax bills have been mailed to the names of the property owners shown on the most recent tax roll. These secured tax bills represent over \$251 million dollars in property taxes that are due and payable to the Tax Collector. "This year, taxpayers will notice an updated QR code on their tax bill payment stubs. When you scan the QR code it will take you directly to your assessment online! No more hassle of typing in your address or assessment." Says Kennedy.

Kennedy is strongly encouraging taxpayers to continue to pay their tax bill(s) by Free E-Check, where your tax payment is posted in real time and a receipt can be printed or emailed for your records. "Paying by E-checks are free, it's fast, reliable, and is a convenient form of payment for our Madera County constituents." Exclaims Kennedy. For taxpayers who wish to drop off their tax check payments, there are two convenient drop box locations. One drop box is located at the County Government Center, while the second drop box will be available beginning December 1st at the Sheriff's sub-station in Oakhurst.

The first installment of the 2022-23 secured property taxes is due and payable on November 1, 2022 and will become delinquent if not paid by December 12, 2022. Since December 10, 2022, falls on a Saturday the deadline is extended to the next business day. The second installment is due and payable on February 1, 2023, and will become delinquent if not paid by April 10, 2023.

We are pleased to now offer a paperless e-Tax Bill service for secured property taxes. You can now receive your property tax bill by email. Join the 400 plus subscribers who joined last fiscal year. If you do not receive your FY 2022-23 secured property tax bill, you can obtain a copy by emailing us at taxcollector@maderacounty.com or by visiting our website. Government Code states that not receiving a property tax bill does not relieve you from your responsibility to pay it on time.
