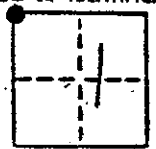

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH  
Found and Accepted: A 2 3/8" O.D. iron pipe, up 14", in a 2' x 2' x 10" high rock mound, with a 2 1/2" dia. brass cap, stamped for the corner, "LS 2737", "W.O. GENTRY" and "9 17 1964".  
 Found the remains of 1 original bearing tree per field notes of Archibald McNeill, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1858.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED  
 Left the monument as found. Rebuilt a 2' x 2' x 18" high rock mound around the found monument.  
 Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached, 4' ± SW of the corner.

- Remains of a fallen Black Oak, 18" ± dia., bears N 51° 35' W, 6.1'. (measurements are to stump hole)
- New Bearing Trees:
- A Ponderosa Pine, 18.2" dia., bears S 6° 11' E, 40.74'. (healed blaze)
  - A Ponderosa Pine, 28.1" dia., bears S 75° 44' W, 60.12'.
  - A Black Oak, 23.4" dia., bears N 9° 59' W, 68.51'. (healed blaze)
  - A Ponderosa Pine, 15.9" dia., bears N 57° 06' E, 23.73'. (partially healed blaze)
