## Wants you to know:

Unsecured tax bills were mailed on July 13, 2023, to the addresses shown on the unsecured tax roll. An unsecured property tax generally refers to property that can be relocated and is not real property. The tax is assessed against such property as business personal property/fixtures, boats, and airplanes.

Failure to receive a tax bill shall not relieve the lien of taxes, nor shall it prevent penalties from being imposed by California Revenue & Taxation code § 2610.5.

Taxes on the unsecured tax roll as of July 31, 2023, if unpaid, are delinquent on August 31, 2023, at 11:59pm. By law, a 10% penalty plus a \$20.00 fee will be added to each assessment. Unpaid taxes accrue penalties at a rate of 1½% per month beginning November 1, 2023.
