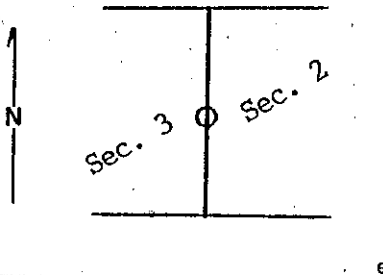

DESCRIBE CORNER LOCATION RELATIVE TO NEAR-BY FEATURES, ALSO HOW TO REACH CORNER

From Madera County Road 221 and Sandy Oak Drive, thence westerly and northerly along Sandy Oak Drive for approx. 3100' to the end, thence westerly for approx. 500' to the posted line, thence north along posted line to the C-W 1/16, thence westerly ascend along drainage for approx. 1320'. Corner is approx. 50-60' north of drainage.

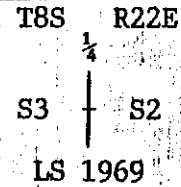

Bearings are to the center of the trees, distances are horizontal to a nail and tag LS 5339 driven into the side center of the root crown. Posted USFS monument and bearing tree signs as required.
