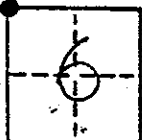

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found and Accepted: A 2 3/4" O.D. iron pipe, up 11", with a 3 3/8" dia. GLO brass cap stamped for the corner and the date, in a 4' x 4' x 1' high rock mound.
Found 4 bearing trees per field notes of A.W. Brown, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1917.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED

Rebuilt rock mound 3' x 3 x 2' high around found monument.
Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached, 4' ± SE of the monument.

1917 Bearing Trees:

1. A Black Oak, 35.5" dia., bears N 10° 39' W, 39.67'.
(healed blaze)
2. A forked Black Oak, 10" dia. (northerly fork), bears
N 77° 20' E, 36.00'. (healed blaze)
3. A fallen Black Oak, 24" ± dia., bears S 3° 14' E, 39.7'.
(bearing and distance are to center of stump hole) (visible scribing, no nail)
4. A Black Oak, 32.6" dia., bears S 39° 36' W, 67.3'. (healed blaze, no nail)

6. A Black Oak, 18.8" dia., bears S 23° 09' E, 71.37'.

7. A Ponderosa Pine, 9.6" dia., bears S 49° 10' W, 48.06'.

Fences run N'ly, S'ly, E'ly and W'ly from a Ponderosa Pine, 23.5" dia., which lies S 31° 38' E, 10.8' from the corner.

Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

Posted Forest Service monument signs on all Bearing Trees and Bearing Tree signs on trees # 6, and #7.

Blazed and scribed bearing trees #6 and #7 in accordance with the BLM 1973 " Manual of Surveying Instructions".

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
