Notes: *Case counts comprise reported cases meeting *Suspect, Probable, or Confirmed* case surveillance classification and does not include cases reported from the two state penitentiaries in Madera County.

Case counts reflect the date the initial disease report was received by the Communicable Disease Control Program.

Totals/Case Counts are provisional (and may change due to delays in reporting from laboratories and providers, the use of different reporting systems, and changes to the final case classification based on subsequent received information). Case count will not include HIV/AIDS due to the confidentiality nature and small number tendency. COVID-19 numbers will not be included due to different data analysis methodology. COVID-19 case numbers can be obtained from the Madera County’s COVID-19 data dashboard.
