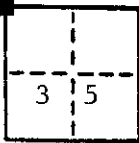

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found 3 original bearing trees per field notes of J.R. Glover, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, 1878. Reestablished corner at record distances from found bearing trees.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

Set F.S.M., up 7". Built a rock mound 2' X 1½' X ½' high around monument. Set a metal post with Forest Service monument signs attached 4' ± NE of corner.

F.S.M. — Aluminum monument, 2 ½" O.D., 30" long with a 3 ¼" O.D. aluminum cap; stamped for the corner, with LS 4689, the date and the Forest Service logo.

Original Bearing Trees:

1. An Oak Snag, 42" dia., bears N8°14'E, 68.1'. (no nail)
2. A fallen Pine, 4½' dia., bears S71°36'E, 58.5'. (no nail)
3. A Black Oak, 25.2" dia., bears S49°59'W, 38.3'. (no nail)

New Bearing Objects:

4. A Black Oak, 12.5" dia. (S'ly fork) bears N 50° 24' E, 72.41'.
5. A Ponderosa Pine, 34" dia., bears S6° 34' E, 139.54'.
6. A Forked Black Oak (NE'ly fork), bears S15° 29' W, 73.93'.
7. A P.K. nail and tag, (LS 4689) on the N'ly end of a rock outcrop 12' X 7' X 4' high, bears N 19° 55' 36" W, 78.38'.

. A 2" O.D.I.P., up 9" tagged LS4509, bears S 6° 02'40" E, 40.99'. (Not Accepted)

. Bearings are to the center of trees at the base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.

. Posted Forest Service Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

. Stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instructions."

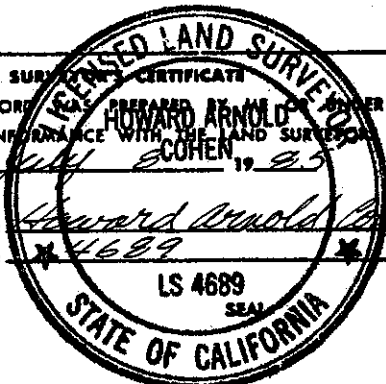
