### **A Message from the Director Darren Rose**

Last month we held our annual Economic Summit/ Real Estate Forecast event for the first time since the pandemic and it was a great success with over 150 in attendance. Our speakers included Sullivan Grosz, President of Pearson Realty who covered the agriculture/ farming industry and retail real estate markets, and Charlie Schuh, Regional Vice President of Colliers who spoke about the industrial real estate market in Madera County and our region. In summary, the market is competitive and vacancy rates remain low.

We also unveiled our new website and logo revision to update our digital properties to properly market Madera County and the cities of Chowchilla and Madera. Our website has a fresher more modern look that will focus on visuals and important information relevant to site selectors, businesses and our stakeholders.

We recently held a meeting with our representatives from Pacific Gas and Electric about expanding their capacity to serve local business expansions and new development projects. Our ongoing meetings and planning with PG&E have been productive and fruitful. Their plans to increase capacity are ahead of schedule and we're hopeful they can continue to meet our future plans and development because it means jobs and revenue.

Finally, we're happy to report that the North Fork Rancheria Casino project at Avenue 17 & SR99 should be moving forward later this year. This project means jobs for our people and increased traffic for local businesses.




