Madera County Treasurer-Tax Collector Tracy Kennedy announced that more than \$70 million in property tax payments were collected and posted within the last 10 days of the April 10 deadline.

“This fiscal year, we have processed more than 130,000 installments, collecting more than \$250 million in current secured and supplemental taxes,” Kennedy said.

Kennedy is also pleased to report that all payments were posted and balanced by April 12. The revenue from property taxes are used for funding local school districts, special districts, and cities.

“My team prepares for each collection season to ensure that payments are posted accurately and timely,” she said. “My team has made several adjustments to our payment processing
