COMMENTS

The Sheriff-Coroner is responsible for the investigation of deaths in this county. The Board of Supervisors provides resources to allow for this function. In FY 2015-16, a decision was made establish a morgue operation and to discontinue the long practice of contracted post-mortem services. Towards that purpose, the County is leasing space for post-mortem facilities and investigation. In FY 2016-17, such costs will be organized under Budget 04034. Certain Coroner services income previously realized in the Sheriff's Operations budget 04010 will now provide revenue to the morgue operations budget. A significant reduction of 04010 Professional and Specialized appropriations will be offset by new operating and technical expenses in the Morgue Operation cost center.

As Coroner, the Sheriff investigates and determines the cause of death, in the absence of a physician, as the result of an accident or due to the criminal action or negligence of another person.

STAFFING NOTE

- (a) The Deputy Coroner position was previously allocated under the Sheriff Admin budget (Org 04010) and is recommended to be allocated and funded under the newly created Morgue Operations budget.
- (b) The Department proposes to fund two new additional Deputy Sheriff's positions to serve as Post-Mortem Investigators. The Deputy positions are recommended to be established on January 1, 2017. The expense of new positions and morgue operations is offset by savings in Professional and Specialized Services and for body storage expense.
