# **COMMENTS**

The Veterans Service Office performs a variety of services for veterans, and their dependents, widows and orphans. This includes assistance in applying for Federal and State programs. The Veterans Service Officer function was separated from the Public Guardian/Public Administrator/Public Conservator's Office in 2009-10, and is now a separate budget unit. Madera County currently contracts with Fresno County for Veterans Services Officer coverage two days per week, and will evaluate this service on an on-going basis. Staff support for the Veteran's Service Office continues to be provided by Madera County.

## **STAFFING** (continued)

\*It is recommended to convert the part-time extra help Office Assistant I to a 0.75 permanent position (30 hours per week) as the department has received a permanent increase in subvention funding.

\*\*The Veterans Service Officer position is currently a contracted position with Fresno County and is funded under Professional & Specialized Services.

### **SALARIES & EMPLOYEE BENEFITS**

710102	<u>Permanent Salaries</u> (\$67,868) are recommended increased \$21,047 based on the cost of recommended staff.
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**710103** Extra Help (\$0) is not recommended, a reduction of \$21,000 due to the conversion of the part-time Office Assistant I to a permanent position.

710200 Retirement reflects the County's anticipated contribution to Social Security and the Public Employees' Retirement System.

710400 <u>Workers' Compensation</u> reflects the Department's contribution to the County's Self-Insurance Internal Service Fund.

## **SERVICES & SUPPLIES**

720300	Communications (\$1,200	)) is recommended increased \$300 based on actual and projected expenditures.
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**720600** Insurance reflects the Department's contribution to the County's Self-Insured Liability Program.

**720800** Maintenance - Equipment (\$75) is recommended unchanged for maintenance of typewriters, calculators, and computers.

**721100** <u>Memberships</u> (\$2,000) is recommended increased \$1,000 for the membership in the California Association of County Veterans Service Officers.

**721300** Office Expense (\$1,800) is recommended increased \$700 to fund the purchase of card readers and signature pads to meet a mandate to convert to a paperless claims process in addition to providing general office supplies.

# **SERVICES & SUPPLIES** (continued)

- **Professional & Specialized Services** (\$61,956) is recommended increased \$2,944 for the contract with Fresno County for Veterans Services Officer services, as approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 7, 2014. The costs for software maintenance contracts and Veteran's computer programs are fully funded by the California Department of Veterans Affairs and do not impact the General Fund.
- **721600** Rents & Leases Equipment (\$1,500) is recommended unchanged for the Department's copier lease.
- **Transportation & Travel** (\$4,500) is recommended increased \$1,000 based on actual expenditures for lodging and meals related to out-of-County conferences/trainings, for which attendance is necessary to receive Veterans subvention funds. Transportation and travel costs are fully offset by revenues specifically allocated by the State for these activities.
