WHAT IS AN HCC?

An HCC is a collaborative network of healthcare organizations, public health agencies, emergency responders, and other stakeholders working together to prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters.

Members attend quarterly meetings, participate in planning, training and exercises, and agree to work with and support members during disaster response and recovery.

- Work together in the planning process to address community and regional preparedness gaps
- Gain access to education, training, exercises, grant funding (through the Hospital Preparedness Program if enough funding is available) and regional assets
