
























I OR MY CHILD GOT THE HELP WE THOUGHT WE NEEDED TOTALS










BETTER AT/MORE EFFECTIVELY HANDLING DAILY LIFE/PROBLEMS TOTALS










IN CRISIS, I WOULD HAVE THE SUPPORT I NEED FROM FAMILY OR FRIENDS TOTALS
