1. FIREBAUGH CSG 1, LLC - PARCEL MAP (PM #4318) & CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP #2024-003)

Firebaugh CSG 1, LLC, requested approval of a resolution approving Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND #2024-07) for Parcel Map (PM #4318) to divide a 556.7 parcel into two parcels (Parcel 1 – 516.7-acres & Parcel 2 – 40-acres) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP #2024-003) to allow the construction of a photovoltaic (PV) community solar and battery storage facility, approximately 6.68MWdc/5.00MWac in capacity, subject to conditions of approval, findings of fact, and the mitigation monitoring report program. The property is zoned ARE-40 (Agricultural, Rural, Exclusive, 40 Acre) District and is located on the north side of Avenue 7, approximately 0.8 miles east from the intersection with Firebaugh Boulevard, (No Situs), Madera. Size 556.7 acres. APN 041-222-005, 041-231-014, 042-081-004, and 042-082-006.

Jacob Aragon, Planner III, presented the information on this item and recommended approval.

Comments: Abby Reed, representing the applicant, spoke in favor of the project.

2. FAIRMEAD ACTION PLAN
