PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Oakhurst is a unique and cherished place by its residents and well known for being The Gateway to Yosemite National Park. This historic and beautiful area has developed over the course of 150 years and incorporates a vast variety of unique natural and man-made features.

As Oakhurst has grown, transportation needs and ways of travel have changed. There are many gaps in Oakhurst's existing transportation infrastructure and the demands on the system have created other safety and connectivity challenges. The County of Madera is seeking ways to complete the transportation network and improve safety while maintaining the quality of the Oakhurst environment and community values.

We are looking to you to help us in identifying issues and opportunities and in seeking solutions to these transportation challenges. Over the course of the next year there will be many opportunities for you to participate in this project and we hope you will join us in the development of this mobility study.

STUDY AREA

The Study Area consists of over ten miles of roadway and also includes an analysis of trail, bicycle, pedestrian and public transit opportunities. Preserving and enhancing public safety is paramount in this study.

- State Route 41: Road 222 to 425B
- Road 426 (Crane Valley Road): SR 41 to Road 427 (High School Road)
- Road 427 (High School Road)
- River Parkway Road: SR41 to Indian Springs Road
- Indian Springs Road: River Parkway Road to Road 427 (High School Road)
- Civic Circle: State Route 41 to Road 426
- Road 426 (Crane Valley Road): Road 427 (School Road) to Hangtree Lane
- Road 428: Road 427 (High School Road) to Hangtree Lane

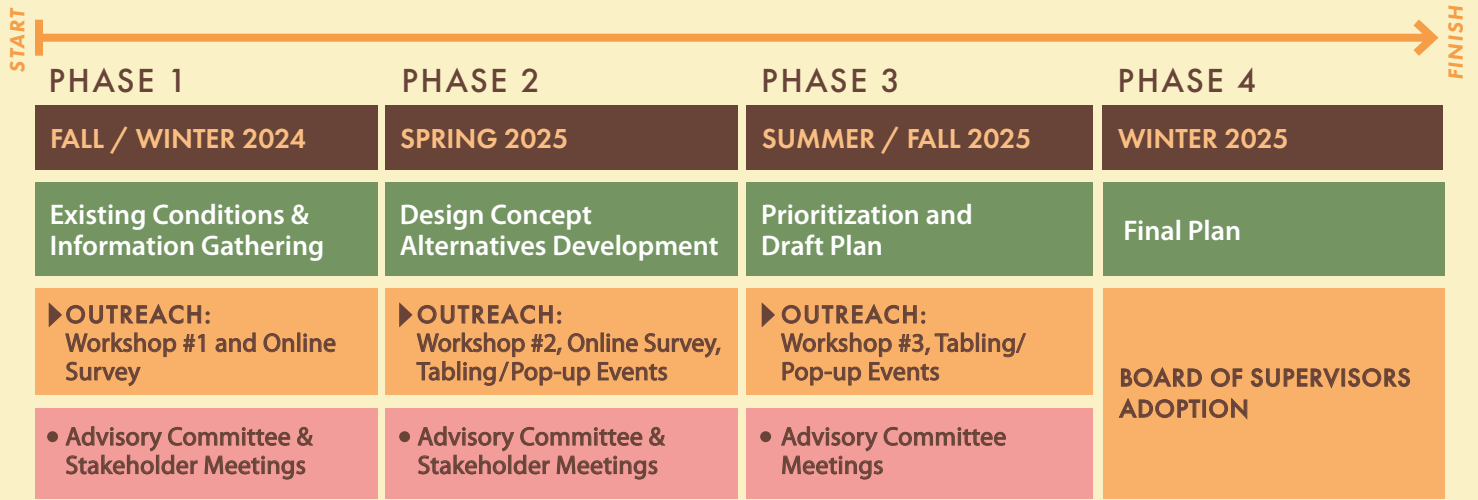
