Wants you to know:

The Unsecured tax bills were mailed on July 12, 2024, to the addresses shown on the unsecured tax roll. An unsecured property tax generally refers to property that can be relocated and is not real property. The tax is assessed against such property as business personal property/fixtures, boats, and airplanes.

Failure to receive a tax bill shall not relieve the lien of taxes, nor shall it prevent penalties from being imposed by California Revenue & Taxation code § 2610.5.

Taxes on the unsecured tax roll are delinquent if left unpaid as of August 31,

2024, at 11:59pm.

**Due to the Holiday, taxes for the FY 24-25 on the unsecured roll will be

delinquent if left unpaid as of September 3, 2024, at 11:59pm.**

By law, a 10% penalty plus a \$20.00 fee will be added to each assessment. Unpaid taxes accrue penalties at a rate of 11/2% per month beginning November 1,

2024.
