COMMENTS

In September 1996, the District Attorney received an Office of Criminal Justice Planning Grant for Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution. This grant provided increased prosecution in teen pregnancies where the mother was less than eighteen years of age and the father was an adult. As of 2007, the grant includes vertical prosecution for statutory rape and child sexual assault. The Prosecutor is also a member of the Child Forensic Interview Team (CFIT), formerly Child Sexual Assault Response Team (CSART), which conducts all child sexual assault victim interviews for the entire County. Due to State budget shortfalls and realignment of the program through the Vehicle License Fee funding schedule, funding for this program expired June 30, 2011. Funding is expected to be restored; however, it is subject to the Governor's approval.
