## **COMMENTS**

In FY 1999-00, the Board of Supervisors established the Sheriff-Civil and Court Security Division budget to provide court security, and Bailiff service, to all Madera County Courts. The establishment of this function was necessitated by the Trial Court Funding Act. The Sheriff's Department administers this function under Org Key 04064. This unit also processes most civil documents on a fee basis. Combining the Civil and Court Security functions in the budget allows greater flexibility in the use of staff to address civil issues when not needed for Court security, resulting in revenue-generating activities and reduced County cost.

## **SALARIES & EMPLOYEE BENEFITS**

710102	<b>Permanent Salaries</b> (\$773,005) are r	ecommended reduced \$26,834 based on the cost of recommended staffing.
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- 710103 Extra Help (\$2,000) is recommended unchanged to provide coverage when staff positions are vacant, or on sick leave.
- **710105** Overtime (\$11,000) is recommended increased \$1,000 based on current usage and anticipated need.
- **710106** Premium Pay (\$500) is recommended increased \$500 based on current usage.
- 710110 <u>Uniform Allowance</u> (\$10,800) is recommended unchanged for the payment of uniform expense for safety employees.
- 710200 Retirement reflects the County's contribution to Social Security and the Public Employees' Retirement System for safety employees.
- 710300 <u>Health Insurance</u> is based on the employer's share of health insurance premiums.
- 710400 <u>Workers' Compensation</u> reflects Department's contribution to the County's Self-Insurance Internal Service Fund.

## **SERVICES & SUPPLIES**

- **720300** Communications (\$1,200) is recommended increased \$200 based on projected FY 2011-12 usage.
- **Microwave Radio Services** (\$6,500) is recommended increased \$1,529 which represents the program's contribution to the Internal Service Fund for use of radios on the County Microwave System.
- **720600** Insurance reflects the Department's contribution to the County's Self-Insured Liability Program.
- **721300** Office Expense (\$1,000) is recommended unchanged for general office supplies.
- **Professional & Specialized Services** (\$4,200) is recommended increased \$700 for the cost of the annual Sirron Software support contract (\$3,700) and other incidental professional fees of the Civil Office.
- **Rents & Leases Equipment** (\$36,500) is recommended increased \$4,500 based on current and projected need for the leasing of Civil Process vehicles from the Central Garage (\$29,000). The account also provides funds for the lease of a copier (\$7,500).

- **T21900** Special Departmental Expense (\$10,000) is recommended to purchase equipment and furnishings using the revenue from the Civil Trust Fund (PC 1325). The funds will assist the Civil Division to accomplish its relocation and consolidation with the Sheriff's Records Unit at 14143 Road 28.
- 722000 <u>Transportation & Travel</u> (\$1,000) is recommended unchanged to provide for training and private mileage cost.
