COMMENTS

This budget provides appropriation of the Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Anti-Drug Abuse (ARRA ADA) grant program under Org Key 04043. In FY 2010-11, this one-time grant precluded position funding deficiencies which were expected in the Byrne Anti-Drug Abuse (ADA) grant program (Org Key 04070). The County Byrne ADA program has been under-funded for over seven years. In recent years, the County General Fund augmented the Byrne ADA program each year. Last year, no County funds were available and three positions in the Byrne ADA program were at risk of elimination.

The United States Government created the ARRA grant program to sustain threatened positions that would otherwise be terminated. In Madera County, ARRA grant funds were used to fund three positions formerly assigned to the Byrne grant program. Last year, the ARRA ADA grant was structured to pay for the salary and benefit costs of one (1) Deputy Probation Officer, one (1) Deputy District Attorney and one (1) District Attorney's Assistant assigned to MadNET. The positions are being maintained at the same level for FY2011-12.

The ARRA ADA program does not require a cash match. Reimbursement is provided from federal funds on a quarterly basis. In 2010-11, the Sheriff's Department received an award of \$314,000; in FY 2011-12, approximately \$82,000 remains unspent and available under the ARRA ADA grant. Full funding for these positions will require county investment due to a significant short-fall in grant funding.
