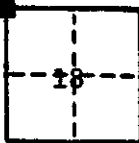

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND, EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found three original bearing trees per GLO notes of Archibald McNeill, Deputy Surveyor, 1858. Corner position established by intersection of record distances from found bearing trees.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS RESULT OR PERPETUATED

Set F.S.M., up 6". Built rock mound 1 1/2' x 2' x 1/2' high around monument. Set a metal post 4'+ NE of the monument with a Forest Service K-tag and Attention sign attached.

F.S.M. - Aluminum monument, 2-1/2" O.D., 30" long with a 3-1/4" O.D. aluminum cap; stamped for the corner, with LS 4689, the date and the Forest Service logo.

Corner Ties

Original Bearing Trees

1. A Black Oak, 33.9" dia., with a healed blaze, bears S 30° 16'E; 60.1'. (no nail)
2. A forked Black Oak, 22.1" dia., with a healed blaze on the central fork, bears N 4° 24'W; 66.0'. (no nail)
Note: Diameter pertains to central fork.
3. A Black Oak, 27.8" dia., with a healed blaze, bears N 57° 06'E; 111.4'. (no nail)

Other Bearing Objects

4. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in a rock 4' x 3' x 5' high, bears N 36° 33' 18"E; 72.59'.
5. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in a rock 5' x 3' x 3' high bears S 16° 37' 12"W; 52.73'.

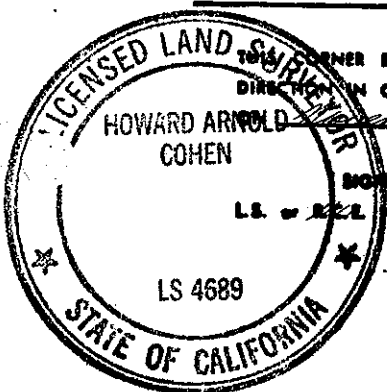

6. A Black Oak, 13.8" dia., bears S 57° 55'W; 73.85'.

7. A P.K. nail and tag (LS 4689) in a rock 9' x 10' and flush with ground, bears N 45° 56'30" W; 45.95'.

* Found a rock mound 2 1/2' at the base and 1/2' high (not original), N 74° 08'E; 10.1'.

- Bearings are to the center of trees at base. Distances are horizontal to a nail and tag (stamped LS 4689) driven into the side center of the root crown, unless otherwise noted.
- Posted Forest Service Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
- Blazed and scribed new bearing tree and stamped monument in accordance with the BLM 1973 "Manual of Surveying Instructions."

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
