Madera County Grand Jury Final Report 1718-01 Central California Women's Facility and Valley State Prison

Summary:

California Penal Code Section 919(b) requires the Grand Jury of each county to make an annual inquiry into the condition and management of the public prisons within the county. In Madera County, there are two public prisons: Central California Women's Facility (CCWF), located at 23370 Road 22, Chowchilla, and Valley State Prison (VSP), located at 21633 Avenue 24, Chowchilla.

The Grand Jury inquiry requirement was fulfilled by visits to both prisons. CCWF was toured on September 12, and VSP was toured on October 10. No problems were observed.

Finding:

F1. The needed building maintenance and repairs identified at CCWF by the 2016-2017 Grand Jury have been addressed.
